






NUMBER OF PRACTISING PHYSIOTHERAPISTS PER 10,000 POPULATION



DISCLAIMER

- The data in this report is based on responses to the annual membership census (AMC) sent to World Physiotherapy's member organisations.
- The AMC was sent to 127 member organisations, of which 119 responded, representing a 93.7% response rate. In the Asia Western Pacific region 30 out of 31 member organisations submitted their AMC data, this represents a 96.8% engagement rate in the region. This is consistent with previous years' response rates and demonstrates strong engagement between World Physiotherapy and its member organisations. The census date was 30 June 2023.
