

Delegate types

16th International Congress of the World Confederation for Physical Therapy

Member

Physical therapists who are members of a WCPT member organisation and who indicate which organisation they belong to on their user account on www.wcpt.org are eligible for the member rate. See www.wcpt.org/members for a full list of WCPT member organisations.

Non-PT educator/researcher

Non-PT educators/researchers who are presenting at World Physical Therapy 2011 are eligible to receive the member registration rate

PT assistant

Individuals currently employed as physical therapist assistants are eligible for the PT assistant rate.

Retired

Physical therapists who are permanently retired from practice at the end of their career **and** who are members of their national physical therapy association are eligible for the retired rate.

Student

Physical therapy students currently enrolled in an academic programme leading to an entry level physical therapy degree, and who are graduating in 2011 or after are eligible for the student rate.

Students who graduated in or before December 2010 are not eligible for the student rate.

The student rate does not apply to physical therapists in post-entry level graduate programmes or to other graduate students.

Non-member

Individuals who are not a member of a WCPT member organisation, and do not qualify for the non-PT educator/researcher, PT assistant, retired or student registration categories must register in the non-member category.
